Peg Vick was unable to attend but Izzy Keppner gave a brief report on fundraising activities noting that their focus is on closing the gap between available funds and the funds needed for various options.

Sidney reported on the ongoing programs at the library. She also thanked the Friends for our continued support at "filling the gaps" in terms of both human and financial resources required to operate the library. Sidney mentioned the very full agenda offered by the library to include basket weaving, chair yoga, book clubs, knitting, and many more activities. Mary thanked everyone who helped with the plethora of events in 2023 and mentioned that we are starting off 2024 with less events but with a continued focus on fund-raising. Mary mentioned that on March 9<sup>th</sup>, we will kick off monthly book sales at the annex. We welcome volunteer help. Mary also mentioned that we have not forgotten about our volunteer recognition—we are aiming for April.

Local author and Oriental resident, Mary Scott, then presented a fascinating account of the events that led her to write Dearest Jim, her writing process, and lessons-learned. It was a fascinating presentation with lots of audience Q&A.
